## Best Practice Tips for Growing Grass in Soils with Moss:

- **Apply iron sulphate to all areas with moss.** Once the moss has been 'killed' or 'browned', rake or scarify the soil to remove all the moss but not beforehand, to avoid spreading the spores.
- **Aerate the soil** (e.g. spiking with a garden fork) and consider putting down feed to enrich the soil.
- **Cut back any over-hanging branches** to allow more sunlight in and ensure you don't over-water the mossy areas (shade and excessive damp/moisture is often the main cause of moss).
- **Ensure you keep the grass height at slightly over an inch**, if you have some grass coverage and plan to mow. This enables the grass to retain its strength and less susceptible to scorching.
